

Signature of Official Documents between Coimbra Group of Brazilian Universities (CGBU) and Institutes of the Higher Education Sector

In the 8th International Seminar and 9th General Assembly, several official documents were signed between Coimbra Group of Brazilian Universities (CGBU) and Institutes of the Higher Education Sector.

On October 25th, during the 1st Brazil-Italy Rectors' Meeting, the Declaration of Parma was signed by the Magnificent Rector of *Università di Parma*, Loris Borgh, Professor Rossana Valéria de Souza e Silva, Executive Director of CGBU, His Excellency Ricardo Neiva Tavares, Ambassador of Brazil in Italy, Magnificent Rector Gaetano Manfredi, President of the Italian Rectors' Council (CRUI).

On October 28th, during the closing ceremony of the events, CGBU has signed international cooperation agreements with Institutes of Higher Education and Universities. CGBU's new partners are: **Universidad Técnica de Ambato**, from Ecuador; and **Universidad Nacional Autónoma de Nicaragua – Managua**, from Nicaragua.

The new cooperation agreements signed in Parma enables the development of new joint actions and improvement of the experience of the group in the international scenario.
